What is the overall deductible?	In Network: \$1,500/Individual, \$3,000/Family Out of Network: Not Covered	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> . amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the plan, each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	Yes. Preventive care/screening/immunization, Primary Care, Specialist Care, Urgent Care, Mental/Behavioral Health, and Substance Abuse Outpatient Services do not apply toward the deductible.
